In The Central Business District And City Center Redevelopment Project Areas**

At our regularly held public meeting on May 8, 2007, the Board of Directors of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council ("DLANC") voted to submit the following motion with respect to the development of City's traffic generation standards and policies.

WHEREAS, using advisory committees selected from the local community or using Neighborhood Councils, and doing actual planning with the assistance of the Planning Department is a model that is good for the City; and

WHEREAS, Neighborhood Councils are in a unique position to assist the City in how it approaches traffic management issues generally.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that DLANC endorses and supports the process of planning in the City through the cooperative efforts of the Planning Department and Neighborhood Councils; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DLANC endorses and supports a City-wide examination of traffic policy, including consideration of creating Los Angeles-specific traffic generation standards, that includes input and collaboration of Neighborhood Councils.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that in developing such standards, priority should be given to Downtown and other areas experiencing rapid development to ensure that new street standards and other effective traffic mitigation measures are considered in the approval process for new projects.

DLANC looks forward to working with your departments to address the City's traffic generation standards and policies.
