At our regularly held public meeting on December 9, 2008, the Board of Directors of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council (“DLANC”) voted to support the above-mentioned request for a Conditional Use Permit (CUB) for a proposed Tony’s Steakhouse restaurant with bar/lounge to be located at 501 and 505 West 6th Street, pursuant to the motion passed on November 18, 2008, by DLANC’s Planning & Land Use Committee.

In particular, DLANC encourages the City to grant all approvals requested in the application by the applicant, including a conditional use permit (CUB) pursuant to L.A.M.C. Section 12.24 W1 to permit the sale and dispensing of a full-line of alcoholic beverages for on-site consumption and live entertainment in conjunction with the proposed Tony’s Steakhouse restaurant and bar/lounge, including outdoor dining. DLANC supports the planned re-activation of a historic building as a new nightlife use serving Downtown’s employees, residents and visitors.
