Dear Zoning Administrator:

At our regularly held public meeting on October 12, 2010, the Board of Directors of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council ("DLANC") voted to support the above-mentioned request for a Conditional Use Permit (CUB) for a proposed 7-Eleven convenience store located at 900 South Broadway Boulevard pursuant to the motion passed on September 21, 2010, by DLANC's Planning & Land Use Committee.

In particular, DLANC encourages the City to grant a conditional use permit (CUB) pursuant to L.A.M.C. Section 12.24 W1 to permit the sale of beer and wine for off-site consumption in conjunction with the proposed convenience store. In deciding to support this request, DLANC considered the applicant's volunteered conditions, specifically a detailed security and safety plan, and limited hours of alcohol sales. In DLANC's view, the information presented provides adequate justification for granting the requested approvals, subject to any additional conditions recommended by the Police Department and the Council Office. DLANC supports this new foodservice retail use which will serve Downtown's employees, residents and visitors.
