At our regularly held public meeting on November 9, 2010, the Board of Directors of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council (“DLANC”) voted to support the above-mentioned request for a Conditional Use Permit (CUB) for a proposed bar/lounge project located at 219 West 7th Street, pursuant to the motion passed on October 19, 2010, by DLANC’s Planning & Land Use Committee.

In particular, DLANC encourages the City to grant all approvals requested in the application by the applicant, including a Conditional Use Permit (CUB) pursuant to L.A.M.C. Section 12.24 W1 to permit the sale and dispensing of a full line of alcohol for on-site consumption in conjunction with the proposed bar/lounge. In deciding to support this request, DLANC considered that the applicant provided a detailed security and safety plan, and also has the support of neighboring residents and stakeholders. In DLANC’s view, the information presented provides adequate justification for granting the requested approvals, subject to any additional conditions recommended by the Police Department and the Council Office. DLANC supports this new nightlife use which will serve Downtown’s employees, residents and visitors.
