

# Item 14

I MOVE that the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee Report relative to the 2020 Redistricting Process be amended to add the following recommendations:

8. Request all appointing authorities to provide a resume and other relative background information for their appointee and that information be publicly accessible.
9. Require all commissioners to complete ethics training prior to taking office.
10. Instruct the City Clerk to provide demographic information on the City's Redistricting Commissions, similar to the demographic information reports that the Clerk provides for other City Commissions.
11. Instruct the City Attorney to draft an ordinance requiring commissioners to disclose all ex parte communications between commissioners and elected officials and their staff.
12. Request the City's Redistricting Commission to avoid hiring current or former city staff that has been out of city service for under a year.
13. Request the City's Redistricting Commission, when possible, to provide more than 72 hours notice of a public hearing.
14. Request the City's Redistricting Commission, when possible, to conduct evening and weekend public hearings to encourage participation of working families in the redistricting process.
