

- Consider location based exclusion:
 - 5th Street Corridor between Hill & Los Angeles Streets
 - Main & Spring Streets between 2nd & 9th Street
 - Central City East Neighborhood east of Main Street

- Consider Limitations on Hours of Operation:
 - Purpose: To prevent targeted nighttime crime from occurring and loitering

- Applicant must provide detail submission of queuing arrangement on the public right-of-way
 - Purpose: To prevent obstruction to passing pedestrians and ADA considerations

- Consider Over-Concentration of Businesses in a Single Neighborhood
 - Purpose: To prevent the over-concentration of retail, cultivation, or manufacturing to one single neighborhood, i.e. Historic Core or Central City East

- Applicant must provide statement of community benefit or contribution
 - Purpose: To show how applicant plans on improving community whether it be public improvement to business frontage, contributions, or social equity

- Consider a Social Equity Component and Prioritization for Local Ownership
 - Purpose: Prioritize businesses that tie into social equity conglomerate, and accelerate businesses that are locally owned, minority owned, and provide pathways to legitimate cannabis operations

- Consider a Limit on the Number of Applications from a Single Owner/Company/Operator
 - Purpose: To prevent monopolization by single owner/company/operator from operating in DLANC boundaries to (1) business
