It's been brought to the attention of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council that the intersection of 9th / Flower poses a safety hazard for pedestrians and cyclists when crossing north / southbound on 9th St. Specifically, the complaints are about the dangers of cars turning left without concern/awareness of pedestrians/cyclists that are crossing the eastern side of 9th St when the S/B light on Flower St is green.

I'd like to request a traffic study to make the case for phased signal prioritization for pedestrians for that intersection.
