CF 22-0051 directs the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) to provide a report on Officer Involved Shootings in 2021.

MOTION

On December 23, 2021, a man entered a Burlington Coat Factory store in North Hollywood and proceeded to randomly assault customers. The Police Department (LAPD) responded to the incident after receiving multiple reports of the assaults. Officers arrived at the scene and after confronting the suspect, opened fire. The suspect would be pronounced dead at the scene. Tragically, a stray bullet fatally struck a 14-year-old Valentina Orellana Peralta who was in a dressing room at the scene.

This most recent incident represents one of several Officer Involved Shootings in the City within the past few years. Each Officer Involved Shooting is investigated by the Force Investigation Division and the Office of the Inspector General for compliance with the LAPD's Use of Force Policies. As several of these investigations remain pending, the Department should provide an update on the status of investigations opened in 2021, as well as a comparative analysis


