It's been brought to the attention of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council (DLANC) that the intersection of 9th / Flower poses a safety hazard for pedestrians and cyclists when crossing north / southbound on 9th Street.

Specifically, the complaints are about the dangers of cars turning left without concern/awareness of pedestrians/cyclists that are crossing the eastern side of 9th Street when the S/B light on Flower St is green.

Therefore, we would like to request that LADOT conduct a traffic study at the intersection of 9th / Flower and investigate the implementation of phased signal prioritization for pedestrians for that intersection.
