Re: DTLA Mobility Investment Plan - Draft Final Project List

To Whom It May Concern:

At our regularly held public meeting on **March 12, 2024**, the Board of Directors of the Downtown Los Angeles Neighborhood Council ("DLANC") voted to provide the following comments below:

The DTLA Mobility Investment Plan's draft project list achieves critical infrastructure investment priorities that will improve our community's pedestrian and multi-modal experience. While the list addresses many of the Neighborhood Council's recommendations to the Department, DLANC recommends that LADOT study the following additional enhancements to the proposed project list provided by the department:

- Study the addition of pedestrian crossing enhancements with HAWK signals or Pedestrian-Activated Flashing Beacons at the following locations:
 - 6th Street / Stanford Avenue
 - E. 14th Place / Central Avenue
 - E. 14th Place / Los Angeles Street
 - W. 15th Place / Hope Street at Dignity Hospital
 - Existing Mid-block pedestrian crossing at 1338 S. Hope (Dignity Hospital Emergency Department)
 - Figueroa Boulevard / Diamond Street
- Create a public space project at the 9th/Main/Spring Streets center median island in the Fashion District, such as a People Streets program plaza. The enhancement should include the closure of the existing slip lane.

- Create a public space project at the median triangle at 3rd Street/Main Street such as a People Streets program plaza.
- Study the addition of new mid-block pedestrian crossings at the following locations:
 - E. 14th Place / Main Street
 - Grand Avenue between 11th and 12th Streets
 - Sacramento / Santa Fe Avenue
 - Francisco Street / W. 8th Place
