Event Sponsorship Options

DTLA Dog Days | June 14 and 15, 2024

For the 16th consecutive year, the DTLA Alliance proudly presents DTLA Dog Days, a free community festival for downtown residents and their dogs at Pershing Square. The event features dog-related activities, vendors, and giveaways. Approximately 1,500 people attend the event annually.

Neighborhood Beautification Project Options

Angel's Flight Landscaping: \$1,700 (see attached estimate)

The DTLA Alliance is interested in partnering with DLANC to clean-up the area underneath Angel's Flight's elevated tracks. This comes at an opportune time to remove debris and overgrown weeds ahead of the influx of summer visitors to this iconic downtown attraction.

The DTLA Alliance is contracted to maintain Angel's Knoll, not Angel's Flight, and therefore, the additional funding would help offset costs to clean-up the space. The landscaping work is typically contracted by Angels Flight Development Corporation, however, due to budget limitations has deferred landscape maintenance this year. The DTLA Alliance has permission by the Angels Flight Development Corporation to partner and complete the immediate landscaping needs.

Hope Street Planters: \$4,800 (see attached estimate)

To help green the Downtown Center, the DTLA Alliance proposes partnering with DLANC to purchase four dwarf trees and dirt to plant in four planters on Hope Street, between 7th Street and 8th Street. The DTLA Alliance will paint the planters and maintain the trees by watering them daily with our Operations Team. In addition, several downtown businesses and residents have expressed interest in participating in neighborhood beautification efforts such as this. The estimated cost is approximately \$1,000 per planter, plus paint.

The Hope Street Planter Project would serve as a pilot for additional tree planning on Hill Street in the Jewelry District.
