***Neighborhood Pet Support & Survival Outreach Program:
Keeping Pets and People Together During Homelessness***

Mission Wellington and his TreatsForPups.com 501c3 animal charity operates the Neighborhood Pet Support & Survival Outreach Program, providing direct compassionate street-level outreach to unhoused individuals and low-income residents with pets across Los Angeles, throughout the San Fernando Valley, and beyond Downtown Los Angeles.

Our charitable program distributes pet food and critical cooling/warming pet supplies to ensure pets remain with their owners and to reduce trauma associated with homelessness.

This project benefits **your** beloved community by supporting vulnerable unhoused residents and promoting humane treatment of their cherished animals.

By providing essential pet supplies to pet owners, our program helps reduce public distress, prevents animal abandonment, and contributes to improved community well-being and safety. *Therefore we often prevent pet abandonment for lack of resources and, and by keeping pets with their people our program is a **much needed pressure reducer** for an already-overcrowded-shelter-system!*

We are already active, our pet food supply is secured, and your NPG funding allows **immediate expansion within your specific district**, rather than starting something new. *It's fast, visible, and low-risk.*

How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large.

All funds will be used exclusively for direct outreach within your boundaries, including:

Critical Pet Cooling/Warming supplies

Outreach & Distribution logistics
Emergency Pet Support Kits

No funds will be used for administrative overhead.

Services will be conducted within your district, including high-need areas where unhoused residents and pets are present.

Funds will be deployed immediately upon receipt, with immediate distribution of supplies through active outreach efforts, *over multiple visits in your council boundaries*, with an average frequency of once every 5 weeks over 6 months.

This program supports vulnerable residents while contributing to cleaner, safer, and more stable neighborhood conditions. Outreach will focus on high-need areas where unhoused residents with pets are highly concentrated and underserved. This program will prioritize outreach in areas with high foot traffic and visible need, honoring your area preferences as well, and providing immediate and tangible community impact.

Supporting pet owners contributes to increased stability and reduces distress in public spaces, helping maintain a safer and more compassionate environment in your streets. Outreach will focus on transit corridors and high-traffic areas where unhoused residents and pets are most present.

As pet food is already sponsored, your NPG funding goes directly to compassionate life-saving outreach and needed survival pet supplies.

Funds will stay solely in your specific district as we track all outreach by location and ensure all grant-funded supplies are distributed within *your* council boundaries. We're happy to provide photo documentation if helpful, along with the end-project summary.

We are not duplicating services already available - In fact, most services for unhoused residents don't accommodate dedicated support specifically their pets. Our program fills that gap directly, allowing individuals to keep their animals while still receiving compassionate and empowering support.

We track the number of individuals served, pets supported, and supplies distributed during outreach. We can provide photos, simple summary if requested, as well as social media tags if desired. We are so grateful to get to look after the cherished pets of your unhoused low-income residents.
